<p>Endaad Native Nonprofit Homes 705-727-8385</p>	<p>Non-profit housing for Indigenous families with 20 units available and rent-g geared-to-income units for families. Wait list minimum of 1.5 years</p>
<p>Empower Simcoe-Regional Housing First Program 705-726-9082</p>	<p>Offers housing first case management, resources to assist with securing and maintaining housing. Weekly housing list of available rentals. Landlord/tenant mediation. Referrals to community services, etc. Intake is done through the Coordinated Access System and by calling 211 or BRAWC's Indigenous Outreach Worker at 705-619+4900</p>
<p>County of Simcoe Social Housing 705-725-7215 and press '3'</p>	<p>Services include access to housing, affordable housing programs, program and subsidy information for local non-profit, co-operative and federal housing.</p>
<p>Supportive Rapid Re-Housing 705-722-3132 ext. 1470</p>	<p>A temporary program designed to assist individuals who are facing homelessness transition into permanent housing within a short period of time (typically 180 days). Clients are considered low-risk individuals who have been impacted by situational homelessness SSRP in Barrie is for seniors (55+) who are preparing for permanent housing.</p>
<p>CMHA-Community Homes for Opportunity (CHO) 705-726-5033 ext. 438</p>	<p>Provides supportive, affordable housing to those who are living with a serious mental illness, which also affects their day-to-day living. This program is not designed to address emergency housing needs; however, the risk of homelessness/ current state of homelessness will be taken into consideration in the application process.</p>
<p>CMHA-Safe Beds Orillia - Short-term Crisis 705-329-5846</p>	<p>Safe Bed in Orillia is three beds, voluntary and non-medical, short-term residential program up to 14 days stay with support staff from 8am to 9pm., 7 days a week. Safe Beds offers crisis intervention and a safe, therapeutic environment for individuals to work through crisis situations and accomplish their goals.</p>
<p>The Lighthouse Orillia 705-329-2265</p>	<p>Providing emergency shelter for men, women and youth including housing, medical clinic and meals.</p>
<p>Barrie East Warming Centre 445 Blake St</p>	<p>Welcomes up to 20 individuals at a time when temperatures dip below -10°C. This temperature-activated warming centre is now pet-friendly, and operates up to seven nights per week, 24 hours per day.</p>
<p>Naadamaadiwag - Helping Each Other Program 705-619-4900</p>	<p>Offers culturally-appropriate support for Indigenous people at risk of, or experiencing homelessness in Simcoe County by providing support services that reduce and prevent chronic homelessness.</p>

NAME	SERVICES OFFERED
Orillia Overnight Warming Centre 64 Colborne St E. 9PM - 7AM	The Orillia Overnight Warming Centre is open for people to stay at when the temperature or wind chill reach -10C.
Green Haven Shelter for Women 705-327-7319	Providing emergency shelter for self-identifying women (and their children) provides housing and supports to women and children escaping gender based violence or intimate partner violence. Outreach services for those living in the community looking to access individual support, peer groups, etc.
Elizabeth Fry Society Simcoe Muskoka 705-725-0613	Provides residential programs for those experiencing homelessness and require onsite supports. The programs are based in housing first, inclusion, and trauma informed principles.
La Maison Rosewood Shelter 705-526-4211	An emergency shelter in Midland that provides housing and supports to women and children escaping gender based violence or intimate partner violence.
Salvation Army Bayside Mission Barrie 705-728-3737	Emergency overnight shelter for men that allows clients to settle with an address while job searching. Provides three daily meals and weekly individual case management with case workers
S.H.I.F.T Alliston 705-435-7293	S.H.I.F.T (Support and Hope for Individuals and Families Today) provides safe, respectful, and welcoming emergency overnight accommodation, meals and supports to those experiencing or at-risk of experiencing homelessness and/or food insecurity in South Simcoe
Busby Centre 705-739-6916	The Busby Centre is a community not-for-profit organization working from a non-judgmental approach to advocate for and improve conditions for individuals and families within South Georgian Bay and the County of Simcoe who are experiencing homelessness or at imminent risk.
The Guesthouse Shelter 705-527-4111	Provides short term overnight shelter including two meals daily for all guests. Laundry and shower facilities available for overnight guests.
Youth Haven Barrie 705-739-7616	Provides transitional housing for youth aged 16-24 and emergency housing for youth between 16-24 who are fleeing an unsafe home or experiencing homelessness.
Barrie Warming Centre 16 Bayfield St 8PM - 8AM	Up to seven (7) days per week based on inclement weather activation. Temperature, wind chill, weather events and at a minimum of -10C or colder. Capacity of the warming centre is eight males at one time.
Barrie Central Warming Centre 113 Tiffin St	Welcomes up to 10 individuals at a time when temperatures dip below -10°C. Open up to seven nights per week, 24 hours per day.

Redwood has grown from just an idea to 49 units of affordable housing created through a number of initiatives: United House for women and children fleeing violence, our Second Suites program through partnerships with Community Builders and homeowners, Lucy's Place for individuals who have experienced chronic homelessness, and now the Family Short-Term Supportive Housing Centre for families experiencing homelessness. Redwood Park also offers furniture bank services.</p>
