<p><b>Orillia Native Women's Group</b> 705-329-7755</p>	<p>Orillia Native Women's Group (ONWG) provides advocacy and support through their program Ezhaabwimoset Ishkodeng S/he walks through fire. The program helps build capacity in survivors, community and agencies. Ensures survivor led strategies and initiatives and nurtures survivor resilience. Develops educational resources and systems navigation. Increases awareness of Indigenous Human Trafficking through workshops, presentations and training across sectors.</p>
<p><b>ONWA Indigenous Anti-Human Trafficking</b> 1-800-667-0816</p>	<p>The Indigenous Anti-Human Trafficking Liaison (IAHTL) Program supports Indigenous communities in providing survivor focused and localized responses to Human Trafficking. The IAHTL initiative was created by and for Indigenous people in order to end Human Trafficking in our communities. Connects those seeking to exit with culturally appropriate, wraparound, trauma-informed supports and services.</p>
<p><b>North Simcoe Victim Services</b> 705-325-5578</p>	<p>Provides assistance 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Provides human trafficking support and advocacy for people experiencing human trafficking in Simcoe Muskoka such as housing, income support, counselling, health care and legal services. North Simcoe Victim Services is partnered with the local OPP detachment in a program called "Operation Northern Spotlight".</p>
<p><b>Canadian Human Trafficking Hotline</b> 1-833-900-1010</p>	<p>A confidential, multilingual service, operating 24/7 to connect victims and survivors with social services, law enforcement, and emergency services, as well as receive tips from the public.</p>
<p><b>Children at Risk of Exploitation (CARE) Units</b> Dnaagdawenmag Binnoojiyag Child &amp; Family Services 705-295-7132</p>	<p>CARE Units are specialized teams of child protection workers and police officers that work with anti-human trafficking community service partners to help identify, locate and engage children who are at risk of sex trafficking, connect those who have been trafficked with the supports they need and hold offenders accountable</p>
<p><b>Huron Transition Homes</b> 705-526-3221</p>	<p>La Maison Rosewood Shelter is the provincial designated shelter for women who are exiting human trafficking situations. Through this program, we provide shelter, support, advocacy and counselling to all women who are exiting human trafficking.</p>
<p><b>Simcoe Muskoka Family Connexions</b> 705-726-6587 ext. 2236</p>	<p>Collaborates with community partners to raise awareness, identify risks, intervene early, and provide support and care for survivors. Provides a model of family-based care for children and youth at risk, or when sex trafficking is suspected or confirmed.</p>
