<p>Rapid Access Addiction Medicine (RAAM) Clinic 705-797-3095</p>	<p>This is a clinic for individuals 16 years of age and up whom are struggling with substance use concerns, or for family members seeking personal support around a loved one's addiction. Referrals will also be accepted but not needed.</p>
